2012 Summer Camp Scholarship Program Packet

February 1 – April 28

WHO IS ELIGIBLE? The members and friends of Trinity Church encourage and support anyone who is interested in participating in a Christian camp, conference or retreat experience this summer. The program is open to adults, youth, & campers of all ages who attend and participate at Trinity. Please consider going or sending a student to a camp/service experience.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

- There are two parts to the Summer Camp Scholarship Program:

SPIRITUAL GROWTH ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS – (see page 3 for details)

Participants earn points when they complete activities and projects from a list intended to encourage spiritual growth.

HOAGIE TICKET SALES – (see page 13 for details)

Participants sell WAWA coupons redeemable for hoagies. One point is earned for each coupon that is sold. **The official envelope must be returned with money by April 15 to receive hoagie sale points.**

- Participants may earn up to half the cost of “camp” through the scholarship program (up to a maximum of \$175.00). Points earned can only be utilized for one event per camper.
- Two (2) FULL scholarships, which include the registration fee, are awarded based on the highest number of points earned through the Spiritual Growth Activities/Projects & Hoagie Ticket Sales.

WHICH CAMPS/LOCATIONS CAN MY POINTS GO TOWARD? Twin Pines Camp, Camp Sankanac, C.E. Work Camp, C.E. Summer Assembly, or a Trinity-sponsored short-term mission trip are just a few of the many opportunities available this summer!

IF I PARTICIPATE in the Camp Scholarship Program, AM I ALSO AUTOMATICALLY REGISTERED FOR CAMP?

NO! You still need to register for the camp itself in order to attend!!!!

OVERVIEW: Spiritual Growth Activities and Projects

Activity and Project points are non-transferable.

1. **ATTENDANCE** - **2 points** for each Sunday school, Church, G.A.K., Youth group (Sun) or Cell group (weekday) meeting attended.
2. **BRING A VISITOR** - **3 points** for each time you bring a visitor. In families with more than one child participating in the contest, only one child may receive credit for the visitor for that event. A person can be counted as a visitor three times.
3. **BRING YOUR BIBLE** - **1 point** for each time you bring YOUR Bible to Sunday school, church, GAK, youth group (Sun,) L2L or cell group (weekday).

For numbers 1, 2, and 3 above, mark dates and points on the Attendance Form provided in the packet (Page 5).

4. **DAILY BIBLE READING** - **1 point** for each day that you read your Bible *at least 15 minutes*. A 10 point bonus will be awarded if the student reads every day of the month. *Mark the Daily Bible Reading form (Page 6).*
5. **CHRISTIAN BOOK REPORTS** (limit of 3) - **10 points** will be awarded for *each* book report submitted on prepared forms. All books must be CHRISTIAN and grade/ability appropriate. *(One form is included in this packet – Page 11).* More blank forms are available at the “Camp Table.”
6. **BIBLE MEMORIZATION** - **Up to 50 points** will be awarded for learning this year’s memory verses for your age group & reciting **as a whole** to your parent or guardian. *(Page 12)* It is up to the parents to discuss and determine that their child has sufficiently memorized the passage. A 10 point bonus will be awarded if last year’s verses can still be recited.
7. **MINISTRY PROJECTS** - **Up to 75 points** for various ministry experiences during the scholarship season. *Record activity on the Ministry Form (Page 13).*
8. **ART PROJECTS** - **maximum 2 projects - Up to 25 points** for each project connected to the arts and Scripture. A group of students may work on a project together and receive equal activity points. Point value depends on the age of the student, originality and creativity, Biblical content, use of materials and neatness, etc. **Clearly label** all projects and place them on the art project display table in the lobby starting April 15, 2012. Evaluation will be done the week of April 22, and projects must be picked up by April 29, 2012.

Please put ALL completed packets on the “Camp Table” in the Lobby.

Remember that nothing will be accepted after the final due date!

HOAGIE SALE INFORMATION

Go for the TWO*
(the two bonus points, that is!)

WHAT INFORMATION DO I NEED TO KNOW? For the 2012 Camp Scholarship program, campers & youth of Trinity Church will be selling coupons redeemable for a Shorti Hoagie from any WAWA Markets. The cost per coupon will be **\$4.00** and may be redeemed at anytime at any WAWA. The hoagies regularly sell for \$3.99 + sales tax, and have no expiration date – these are good selling points! Each hoagie coupon sold is worth ONE point in the scholarship program.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE? During the months of March (**Sunday mornings February 26 to April 1**) visit the “Camp Table” between services to obtain your coupons.

- You will ***not*** need the money to pick up coupons at this time, only an estimate of how many coupons you will need.
- Once you have your coupons you simply sell the coupons to friends & family and inform them where to redeem the coupons.
- You will earn ***two bonus points** when you sell your first complete block of 25 coupons.
- You will receive an official envelope for the return of money and any unsold coupons. Remember to fill it out completely.
- You will not be charged for the coupons you don't sell.

WHEN IS THE MONEY DUE? Your money is due on or before **April 8, 2012** and can be dropped off at the “Camp Table” or placed in the McLaughlins’ church mailbox. Be sure to use the return envelope and fill it out completely.

The official envelope MUST be turned in with the money by April 8 for points to be assigned. No envelope means you will receive no points!

Checks are to be made payable to “Trinity E.C. Church.” The money raised from the hoagie sales will go toward the Camp Scholarship Program.
